CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

Since our inception 10 years ago, the Institute for Marketplace Transformation (IMT) has grown significantly, even though it is a tiny organization in the huge global movement of faith and work. But we feel like we have a contribution to make.

Jeff Hannen in his *Christianity Today* article recently said, "The faith and work movement has been geared toward power and cultural influence, but the future of the movement, I believe, will be rooted in spiritual formation. Work is not only about success, influence, or even gospel impact — it's about who we're



becoming as followers of Christ." One dimension of depth we are seeking at IMT is spiritual—spiritual formation before and after work, and through work. But another dimension of needed depth is theology. And theology is not only head stuff but concerned with the heart (prayer) and the hand (practice).

So where are we now? First our regions (North America, Hong Kong, South-East Asia, Taiwan and South Korea, and other insipient regions) are contextualizing our content and "training trainers" which is what we are doing in our critical and intensive year long Fellows program. Second, we are developing a group of Senior Fellows, marketplace theology educators who will be able to teach in seminaries, Fellows groups, conferences and churches—globally. Third, we are publishing a three volume work under the title, Working Blessedly Forever, which will be a resource to people and groups who want to know why we are integrating faith and work. Fourth, we are expanding our leadership group as I take a more focused and less comprehensive role in the movement.

In all of this we have seen the gracious hand of God, in supplying the people we need, in seeing people become more mature whole-life disciples of Jesus, in financial and prayer provision, in seeing people growing in their integration of faith and work. What a joy to see people feeling, when they go to work, that they are doing "the Lord's work," working with God, and bringing in the kingdom of God as a coworker with God through their work and witness. Augustine said it so well in the fourth century: "God without us will not, as we without God cannot."

YEAR IN REVIEW



The IMT Fellows program is a 12-month intensive learning community designed to help Christians grow in their integration of faith and work with a strong biblical, spiritual and theological foundation, and to prepare them to be trainers and servants of others. In 2023, we had Fellows Programs in North America, Taiwan, Southeast Asia, Hong Kong, and Korea. Taiwan, Southeast Asia, and Korea graduated their first cohorts in 2023.

Since 2021, the IMT team has been publishing Marketplace Theology articles on the IMT website, as well as reflections about faith & work. We were delighted to have 7 writers contribute articles to our website this year. Overall, our articles were viewed 9,495 times, which is a 59% increase from 2022.





In 2023, our senior fellows team taught at many seminaries, churches, conferences, and groups all around the world. A few highlights were Dr. Paul Stevens teaching two courses at Regent College and one course at ACTS Seminary, inviting senior fellows and others from the IMT community to co-teach with him. Earlier in the year, he spoke to over 200 students at Crandal University in Moncton, New Brunswick. Dr. Wilson Chan spoke at a faith and work conference in Calgary, which was organized by two IMT Fellows.



From May 5-7, 41 participants met at Westminster Abbey in Mission, BC for an IMT Retreat. Paul Stevens, Brenda Halk, Wilson Chan, Al Erisman, David Robinson, and Jean Lee were the speakers. It was a great time of learning, encouragement, and fellowship.

In 2023, we translated one of our courses (MM2 Aging Matters) into Korean and one of our Fellows participants translated two episodes of Doing God's Business into Portuguese as a pilot project. We also added MM17 Ministry and Spirituality to our course platform. This course is really special as it was taught in 1989 by Regent College's first principal Dr. James Houston along with a young Dr. Paul Stevens.

In 2023, we had 361 new people register for our online courses. All our courses are available for free at courses.imtglobal.org.



IMT offers a five-module program for those interested in deepening their understanding and practice of engaging their faith in the marketplace, leading to the Certificate of Marketplace Transformation. This year we had 6 students working on the certificate program, with 1 of them graduating. 5 students from East Africa are expected to complete the certificates in early 2024.



IMT launched the Doing God's Business podcast in 2020 with a short 3 episode season, followed by a 10 episode season in 2021. Dr. Paul Stevens and Tim Chan interview guests in various industries (Retail, Finance, Non-Profit, Law, Business, and Advertising) as they share how they integrate their Christian faith with their everyday work. In 2023 there were 664 downloads of our podcast episodes.



IMT continues to use various methods to equip and empower Christians to live out their Kingdom calling in the world. 8950 people have visited the IMT website in 2023. Our website is the home base of all our resources, including articles, books, and courses.

We have 1312 email subscribers who receive our latest marketplace theology articles and invitations to join our events and courses. And we have 520 social media followers on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, and LinkedIn.





NEW RESOURCES

In 2024 we will launch two new faith and work integration resources. The first is a book by Paul Stevens, *Working Blessedly Forever: The Shape of Marketplace Theology*. This book will be available in the Spring of 2024, and IMT will host a book launch event to celebrate.

The second is an online course taught by our senior fellow, Dr. Steve Garber. The course is titled *The Seamless Life* and will challenge Christians to see all we are and all we do (work, play, relationships, worship, and loves) as significant to God.

FELLOWS GROUPS

Interest and participation in IMT Fellows Groups continues to grow. North America is launching three Fellows group this year, with all three groups being co-led by past Fellows graduates who are joining the leadership team. Hong Kong has three Fellows groups currently running, with IMT Taiwan, IMT Korea, and IMT Southeast Asia all planning more Fellows groups in the future.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Starting in June 2024, Paul Stevens will focus his role at IMT on writing and teaching, and pass off duties of running IMT to a new Executive Director. Please pray for this transition.

TEACHING

Paul Stevens and the rest of the senior fellows will be teaching seminary courses and speaking at conferences, events, churches, and at IMT Fellows groups throughout the year, helping Christians deepen their integration of faith and work.
